



# JUWENALIA ŁÓDZKIE 2017

Juwenalia is a students' holiday, time for entertainment, concerts and leisure.

Juwenalia is a mass event.

What does it mean?

It means that when entering the student campus there are rules that must be followed by all without exception.

Only adults are allowed to enter the restricted area.

The identity card must be shown at the request of security service.

It is forbidden to bring and to carry the following items to the event:

- weapons or other dangerous items,
- explosives,
- pyrotechnic articles,
- hazardous materials that can cause fire,
- alcoholic beverage other than those distributed by the event management,
- narcotic drugs or psychoactive substances,
- beverages in plastic, glass, metal and cardboard containers.

Anyone who is under the influence of alcohol, drugs or psychoactive substances, will not be allowed to the event.

It is forbidden to:

enter or pass through buildings and appliances not intended for general use (fences, walls, gates, trees, roofs, etc.),

enter areas that are not intended for participants,

throw objects,

sell, advertise, trade, perform fundraising without the event management consent,

go to the toilet in other areas than WC facilities,

walk dogs and other animals,

ride bicycles and other vehicles,

cause fire,

bring food to the restricted area.

Enjoy Juwenalia and follow the rules. Be tolerant to others. If you see something disturbing, report to the Police or appropriate services. If there is panic in the crowd – stay calm and obey the instructions from security personnel. The event management informs and warns that the violation of the rules of the mass events is punishable by imprisonment up to 2 years, restriction of freedom or fine of at least PLN 2 000.
